Summary

This section provides information to help prepare students to take the exam and to register for the exam.

Students will also have the opportunity of testing their mastery of the concepts presented in this course to reaffirm that they are ready for the certification exam. For example, all questions that apply to **Objective 100. IP Addressing** are grouped together and presented in practice exam **Objective 100: IP Addressing, All Questions.** Students will typically take about 60-90 minutes to complete each of the following practice exams.

Objective 100: IP Addressing, All Questions (92 questions) Objective 200: Name Resolution, All Questions (88 questions) Objective 300: Network Access, All Questions (65 questions) Objective 400: File and Print, All Questions (130 questions) Objective 500: Monitoring and Managing, All Questions (42 questions)

The Certification Practice Exam consists of 50 questions that are randomly selected from the above practice exams. **Each time the Certification Practice Exam is accessed different questions may be presented**. The Certification Practice Exam has a time limit of 135 minutes -- just like the real certification exam. A passing score of 95% should verify that the student has mastered the concepts and is ready to take the real certification test.
