Downloading and importing publisher Test Banks into Blackboard



1. Go to the publisher's web site and log in. (we are going to use Cengage as an example)

2. Enter the Author, Title, or ISBN in the form box and select "Search."



3. Select the learning materials that you are using and then select "Continue".
